Transitions is for female residents who have been incarcerated or who are/have been on parole or probation. There are six beds available for women who fall into this category.

The Resident Services Coordinator oversees the program and offers personal mentoring for all participating women. A support group meets at Our House every Thursday at 7 p.m.

We help by offering the following services:

- On-site educational & job training programs
- Access to public benefits
- Develop goal plans with on-site counselors
- Services from the case management team
- Substance abuse recovery programs
- Life Skills courses (Money Management, Parenting)
- Help finding full-time employment
- Mandatory savings program
